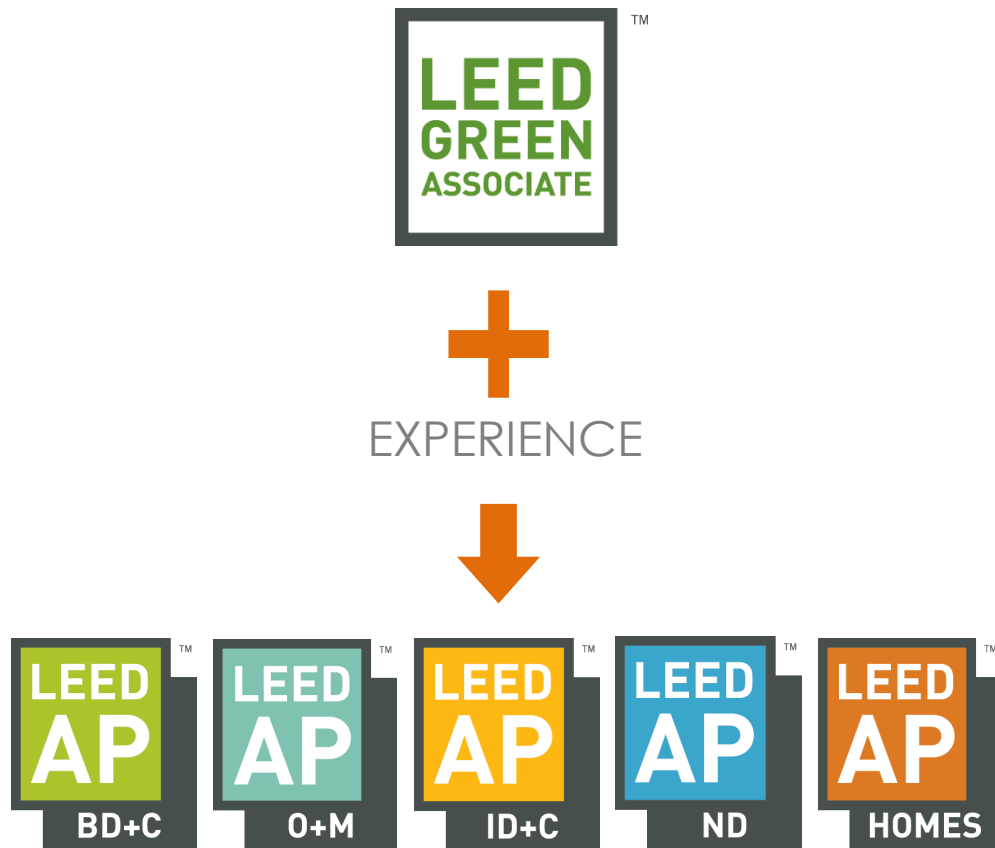


PATH TO BECOMING A LEED AP



HERE'S HOW:

If you are just starting on your path toward a LEED Professional Credential, remember these four steps:

- 1) **Download the [GBCI candidate handbook](#)** for the credential you are seeking.
- 2) **Determine if you meet eligibility requirements.** The LEED Green Associate eligibility requirement can be satisfied by taking USGBC's LEED 201 Core Concepts + Strategies workshop, which also helps you prepare for the exam ([learn more »](#)). To take the LEED AP exams, you must have previous experience with a LEED-registered project within three years of your application submittal date.
- 3) **Register** for the exam at gbc.org.
- 4) **Start studying!** USGBC Colorado offers various exam preparation opportunities. Study Groups, Full-day workshops facilitated by LEED Faculty™, USGBC Colorado LEED BD+C Study Guide, and more. Visit usgbc.org today for more information!
