- Minimum year commitment to position (2-6 hours a month)

- Creative thinker, leadership and communication skills
- Be able to dedicate knowledge/expertise on behalf of USGBC without conflicts with professional obligations or opportunities
- **Chairs and Branch Representatives:** Ability to attend monthly meetings for Chapter Education Sub-Committee and alternating months Strategic Chapter Education Committee or Branch Education Committee - depending on role
- **Volunteers:** Ability to attend 50% of monthly meetings for Chapter Education Sub-Committee (2-4 hours a month)
