



# Call for Judges of Green School Contest

**Be a part of QA Graphics' Showcase Your School's Green Efforts contest**

**The Contest** QA Graphics is seeking help in judging entries of their Showcase Your School's Green Efforts contest. We are looking for people involved in schools and/or the green building industry that are willing to help review the schools' contest entries.

QA Graphics is calling for entries from schools nationwide, asking them to share what steps have been taken to green their school. They want to reward schools for their sustainable efforts and provide a solution that will help educate the next generation about being green. Two schools will be awarded an Energy Efficiency Education Dashboard to showcase their school's green initiatives. Each prize is valued at approximately \$7,000 each.

**Volunteer to Judge** Your involvement would consist of volunteering just a few hours to help review a small number of the contest essays submitted to help narrow the list of finalists. Assistance would be needed sometime during April 1- 23, whenever is most convenient for you. The selection process will be based on the guidelines below.

**Contest finalists will be selected based on the following criteria (entries are based on 100 possible points):**

1. The initiatives have improved the overall environmental health of the school (i.e., the school makes a smaller environmental impact, has improved resource consumption, or is saving money in a result of sustainable efforts, etc.) (50 points)
2. The initiatives are sustainable (resulting in a long-term positive impact) (35 points)
3. Quality of the essay (15 points)
4. Entries may include up to 5 photos documenting the school's green initiatives
