**** DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR TOUR****

People who want to join us for the tour need to wear long pants (no capris) and closed-toed/closed-back shoes (no heels). Also, no tank tops are allowed.



- Partnership formed between Ascent 54 brand and Colorado Fourteeners Initiative.
- Landfill diversion rate of 99.4% includes recyclables such as grain, aluminum, glass, and plastic.
- Waste beer is distilled and sold as fuel additive.
- Carbon dioxide is collected, purified, and re-used to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- Brewery has reduced energy usage by 11% in the last five years.
- Energy crops are grown at local A-B land application site and the biodiesel produced from them is used in on-site equipment.
- Evaluating installation of wind power locally and other renewable energy projects domestically.
- Have dedicated eight acres of brewery property as a habitat for birds, pollinators, and small mammals. Land is certified by the Wildlife Habitat Council.
- Gold level partner of ClimateWise, a local organization focusing on greenhouse gas emission reductions from businesses.
- Employees have planted 2700 trees in the community over the last three years.
